

EXCELLENCE IN ECONOMICS (EXEC)

The UCLA Department of Economics and the UCLA Alumni Association are committed to the successful transition of transfer students to the campus community. The EXEC program will equip first-year transfer students with the skills and resources to excel academically, socially, and professionally.

Program Format & Requirements

Academic Preparation: EXEC students are required to take Econ 11 (Microeconomic Theory) and Econ 97 (Economics Toolkit) together during the fall quarter. EXEC students will enroll in one of two discussion sections of Econ 11 reserved exclusively for EXEC students.

Career Preparation: Students are also required to participate in career planning sessions led by Gerald Corporal, Director of Alumni Career Engagement. These sessions will assist students with their resume, elevator pitch, developing a strategy for internship recruitment, and connecting with alumni. Students will also receive a peer mentor; a second year transfer student.

Eligibility

Currently, EXEC is only open to new transfer students (entering UCLA in Fall 2022) from the following majors:

- Pre - Economics
- Pre - Business Economics
- Pre - Math/Econ
